



Greetings! It has been such an amazing year at Eternal Anchor. As a new ministry, we had no idea where God was going to take us. We started with one boy, no money, and only one clear purpose: to provide hope and a home to children with special needs. God has taken that purpose and vision and has expanded it in ways we never expected.

Our home started with Jesús in December of 2014. Since then, we've taken in three more precious boys: Angel, Mirrain, and Alfredo. We strive to provide a loving home for these boys where their physical, emotional, and spiritual needs are provided for and where they can reach their God-given potential. We are currently purchasing land where we plan to build homes that will house 10 children.

Soon after we started Eternal Anchor's home, God opened our eyes to a massive need in our community. There are hundreds of children in the San Quintin Valley that have special needs. Sadly, there are only a few places capable of helping these children. In the communities that we visited, none of the children had the opportunity to go to school or daycare and very few of them had access to physical therapy. We decided to open a community center and work alongside parents and

community volunteers to meet this need.

In February, we started with three children in a borrowed Sunday school room. We now have 35 children in our program and have been lent a beautiful facility in Zapata. Every day, Eternal Anchor staff, community volunteers, and parents work together to provide physical therapy and special education to the children in our program.

In July, we had our first Love Extended campaign. Two physical therapists came to work with our staff and volunteers and to visit homes to train families. In one week, 39 families were visited and given training in physical therapy.

In December, we started a weekend life skills class for adults with special needs. They learn cooking, crafts, and other skills that will help them contribute to their families.

None of this could have been possible without God's provision and the generosity of those who have partnered with Eternal Anchor. Thank you so much for your kindness and for your gifts in 2015. We are so excited to see what God has planned for Eternal Anchor in 2016! Please continue to pray with us and partner with us in the new year as we serve those with special needs in Baja California.
